

Bar Gun Cleaning Procedures



Bar Gun Nozzle

Nozzle Brush

DAILY

1. **Clean Bar Gun.** In a small bucket, swish around Bar Guns in warm water for no longer than one minute to remove syrup from gun frame. Remove nozzle and use brush to remove syrup build-up. Rinse again if necessary. Allow to dry at room temperature.
2. **Clean drip cup.** Pour warm water down drip cup.

Note: DO NOT USE ammonia, bleach, steel wool, scouring pads, or abrasives when cleaning bar guns.

WEEKLY

1. **Sanitize Bar Gun.** In a small bucket, swish around Bar Guns in mixture of warm water and sanitizer for no longer than one minute to remove syrup from gun frame and to sanitize the gun. Allow to dry at room temperature. Run each flavor 1-3 seconds to remove sanitizer.
2. **Sanitize Drip Cup.** Pour Sanitizer solution down drip cup.
3. **Clean syrup connectors.** Disconnect syrup line from empty bag-in-box and soak connectors in a solution of chlorinated detergent, like K5(Coca-Cola part number 25823) and warm water (90oF to 110oF) for two to three minutes. *Rinse* connectors in warm, drinkable water and connect them to a full syrup container.

MONTHLY

1. **Clean ice bins.** Wash down inside walls of jockey box and aluminum surface of cold plate with warm water mixed with sanitizer(K5) using a soft clean cloth. Rinse completely with clean, warm water.
